### ***Star Spangled Banner***

One of the most beautiful and inspirational settings of our national anthem ever written.

### **El Relicario – Jose Padilla/Robert Longfield**

One of the most famous and best loved paso dobles ever written, this classic work from the rich heritage of band literature is here presented in a setting by Robert Longfield that reveals all of its fiery rhythms and sweeping Spanish melodies.

### **Themes from How to Train Your Dragon – John Powell/Sean O'Loughlin**

The music for this hit movie features magnificent adventure themes along with hints of Celtic influences.

### **March of the Sun Dried Tomatoes - Julie Giroux**

From the composer: “This is the woeful tale of a day in the kitchen with a recipe that called for, among other things, sun-dried tomatoes and red wine. I like to think of myself as a cook, though I cannot convince many others of that fact, but had not encountered sun-dried tomatoes before. ### **The Greatest Generation - Robert W Smith**

Written for the 75th Anniversary of the attack on Pearl Harbor and gathering of heroes from around the world, this stirring composition pays tribute to America's "Greatest Generation." Beginning with a heroic fanfare, the piece transforms into lush and melodic underscoring to the historic text originally narrated by World War II and Normandy veteran Col. Arnauld D. Gabriel. A perfect selection to honor those that have served in the armed forces.

### **Appalachian Morning – Robert Sheldon**

The traditions of Appalachia were largely influenced by settlers from Scotland and Ireland. This reflective piece acknowledges these pioneers and their musical heritage with a musical walk through the woods and mountains of the Cumberland Gap.

### **With Ever Joyful Hearts - Erik Morales**

Commissioned by *The Wachovia Winds Youth Wind Ensemble*

The full gamut of emotions and styles are covered in this substantial work that pays homage to the Moravian heritage, using Nun Danket and Hosanna for the basis. Opening with the simple sound of chimes, the work begins to develop as the brass interject brilliant fanfares. Woodwind flourishes abound throughout the piece amongst expressive and lyrical lines.
